**JOURNAL ENTRY OF DEFAULT JUDGMENT
FOR FAILURE TO ANSWER ADVERSARY COMPLAINT**

On the date written below, this Court considered the Application for Entry of Default Judgment for Failure to Answer Adversary Complaint (the “Application”) submitted by the Debtor/Plaintiff, American Stress, Inc. After reviewing the Application and its attachments and the court file in this Adversary Proceeding, and being fully advised in the matter, the Court finds as follows:

1. On March 8, 2004, the Plaintiff filed a Complaint in the above captioned adversary proceeding seeking a judgment against the Defendant of a sum certain; to wit: \$23,783.88.
2. The Bankruptcy Court Clerk issued a Summons to the Defendant, Murat Baykal, on March 8, 2004, and according to the Plaintiff’s Service Return Affidavit, the Summons and a copy of the

Complaint were served together on the Plaintiff via regular first class mail at the Defendant's home address and two separate business addresses on March 10, 2004.


3. According to Rule 7012(a) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the Defendant was required to submit his answer or other response to the Complaint within 30 days (plus 3 days for mailing) after issuance of the Summons. As of the date of this Journal Entry, according to the Court's record, the Defendant has failed to answer or otherwise respond to the Complaint and the Defendant has not entered an appearance.

4. It appears from the Application for Entry of Default Judgment and the Affidavit of Paul R. Tom attached thereto that the Plaintiff has complied with the Soldiers and Sailors Civil Relief Act and that the amount claimed is a sum certain.

5. In accordance with Rule 7055 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure incorporating Rule 55 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the Plaintiff is entitled to a Judgment against the Defendant, Murat Baykal, in the amount of \$23,783.88, plus costs.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Plaintiff/Debtor, American Stress, Inc. is hereby granted a *judgment* against the Defendant, Murat Baykal, in the stated amount of \$23,783.88 plus the costs of filing this action of \$150.00, with interest to accrue on said judgment at the statutory rate from and after the date of this Journal Entry.
