IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Debt owing to the Plaintiff herein by the Defendant, Jonathan Wilson, is nondischargeable and that collection of the said debt shall in no way be barred by these proceedings and that the Plaintiff, SEARS, ROEBUCK AND COMPANY, have and recover judgment against the Defendant, Jonathan Wilson, for the sum of \$1623.00 at 21 percent interest. Each side will pay its own attorney fees. The Defendant will pay \$150.00 court costs.
