

4. On November 6, 1997, pursuant to the filing of said Motion, the Court issued an Order Regarding Motion for Order of Civil Contempt, therein requesting that the Motion be pursued as an adversary proceeding, and ordered said Motion to be served by appropriate Summons to Defendant.


5. Pursuant to said Order, a Summons was issued and Defendant was served via certified mail, restricted delivery, on November 18, 1997, as evidenced by proof of service filed herein.

6. The time for filing an answer or other response expired on Thursday, December 18, 1997, and no answer or other response has been filed herein or otherwise served on Plaintiff by Defendant.

7. Therefore, Defendant is in default, and the Motion of Plaintiff is taken as true and correct, and confessed by the Defendant.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the findings of the Court above on are incorporated herein this Order as fully set forth; that the Motion for Order of Civil Contempt served herein as an Adversary Complaint is taken as true and correct and is hereby granted in full against the Defendant; and, that Plaintiff is awarded judgment against Defendant for her damages suffered in the amount of \$796.00.
