**STIPULATED JUDGMENT**

The above matter comes on before the Court on this 7 day of April, 1997. The parties announce to the Court that they have reached a full and complete settlement of all issues herein and request that the Court approve the following stipulated judgments:

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the indebtedness due to the Plaintiff, AT&T, by the Defendant, James H. Farmer, in the amount of \$6,682.61 is determined to be non-dischargeable.



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Defendant is hereby granted a stay of execution conditioned upon their payment to the Plaintiff of \$4,000.00, payable in consecutive monthly payments of \$100.00 per month beginning May 15, 1997 and each month thereof until the sum is paid in full.


