AGREED ORDER OF JUDGMENT

THIS MATTER having come on for consideration this 26 day of February, 1998, upon Stipulation of the Parties, the Court finds that:

1. The Defendant's post-petition perfection of its pre-petition security interest in and to the Debtor's 1994 Chevrolet Lumina, VIN # 2G1WP14X8R9104623 constitutes a voidable transfer pursuant to 11 U.S.C. 549.


2. That the Plaintiff/Trustee's interest in and to the referenced vehicle is prior and superior to the interests of the Defendant.
