**AGREED JOURNAL ENTRY OF JUDGMENT**


This matter comes before the Court on the Complaint of Plaintiff, State Bank & Trust, N.A., to deny discharge. The Court being fully advised in the premises, finds, as evidence by the signatures of Counsel hereto, that the parties agree and stipulate that judgment should be entered herein.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that judgment is entered herein in favor of the Plaintiff, State Bank & Trust, N.A., such that an obligation in the amount \$2,700 is owed by Debtors to State Bank, and which obligation is deemed non-dischargeable.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED however, that any obligation owed to State Bank by Debtors in excess of \$2,700 is deemed dischargeable; and therefore, said amounts in excess of \$2,700 will be discharged in the ordinary course of Debtors' Bankruptcy.
