PARTIAL JUDGMENT

This action came on before the Court pursuant to the stipulations of the parties as evidenced by the parties' signatures on the stipulated Order for Judgment filed concurrently herewith. On the basis of said stipulations,

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED

The Plaintiff, 66 Federal Credit Union, Bartlesville, Oklahoma, recover judgment of the Defendants, Bobby Clovis McGonigal and Patty Sue McGonigal, in the sum of \$3,737.93, together with interest thereon at a rate of 12.25% per annum from April 30, 2000 until paid in full, said sum having been determined to be nondischargeable pursuant to Section 523(a)(2), Title 11 U.S.C.

FURTHER, the Plaintiff, 66 Federal Credit Union, Bartlesville, Oklahoma, recover judgment of the Defendants, Bobby Clovis McGonigal and Patty Sue McGonigal, for its statutory costs of collection, its litigation costs and attorney's fees in the sum of

\$1,850.00, which shall be consolidated with the above-referenced principal balance and made part and parcel of the repayment schedule as set forth below.


Execution on this judgment shall be stayed as long as the Defendants commence installment payments on or before the 1st day of June, 2000, in the amount of \$186.33 per month, and maintain like installments to be due and paid on or before the 1st day of each succeeding month thereafter in the amount of \$186.33 per month, until said judgment is paid in full, which payments shall extend over a period of approximately thirty-six (36) months. Provided, however, in the event of default in any timely payment called for by this order and resulting judgment, the entire balance shall immediately become due and payable without further notice to the Defendants, for all of which let execution immediately thereafter issue.
