JUDGMENT

Pursuant to the Order Granting Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment entered on May 24, 2001, judgment on the Complaint for Turnover of Property of Debtor's Estate and Other Relief (the "Complaint") is entered in favor of Plaintiff Commercial Financial Services, Inc.
