JUDGMENT AVOIDING LIEN

1. The interest and lien of the Defendant regarding the following described property, to-wit:

should be avoided as a preferential transfer pursuant to 11 U.S.C. Section 547(b) and (e) and 47 O.S. Section 1110 A.2.

2. The Proof of Claim of Defendant should be disallowed as a secured claim and classified as a general unsecured claim in the amount of \$10,224.72.

3. That Judgment should be entered in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendant as set forth above and in Plaintiff's Complaint.


