DEFAULT JUDGMENT JOSEPH QUARTELL (QUARTELL)

THIS MATTER having come on for consideration this 7 day
of March, 2002, upon Plaintiff/Trustee's Motion for Default
Judgment against QUARTELL, the Court finds as follows:

1) That on the 2nd day of April, 2001, Malloy instituted
this adversary proceeding against QUARTELL seeking to avoid
QUARTELL's lien against any and all real estate owned by the


estate in the State of California, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. 549. In addition, Malloy seeks a determination that the tax lien of the United States of America ex rel (IRS) in and to all proceeds derived from the sale of the estate's interest in Sylmar and Pismo Beach, California totaling \$176,453.92 is prior and superior to the interest of QUARTELL.

2) That proper and timely service of the Complaint and Summons was made upon the Defendant JOSEPH QUARTELL on the 3rd day of April, 2001, as evidenced by the certificate of service filed herein on the 7th day of August, 2001. That the Defendant JOSEPH QUARTELL has failed to answer or otherwise plead.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Plaintiff/Trustee is hereby granted a Default Judgment against QUARTELL avoiding any and all liens of QUARTELL in and to any and all real estate owned by this estate wherever located in the State of California.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the interest of the (IRS) in and to all proceeds derived from the sale of the estate's interest in real estate located in Sylmar and Pismo Beach, California, totaling \$176,453.92 is prior and superior to the interest of QUARTELL.
