JUDGMENT AVOIDING LIEN


On April 3, 2002, there came on before the Court the Motion to Avoid Lien Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §522(f), to cancel a security interest which impaired an exemption of the debtor(s) PAM FULTZ. Upon consideration of the evidence and examination of the file in this matter, the Court finds that the allegations contained in the Motion to Avoid Lien Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. Section 522(f) are true and correct: That World Acceptance Corporation, 100 E. 2nd, Sand Springs, Oklahoma 74063, claims a lien upon certain household goods and other personal property which are exempt property of the debtor(s) and that said lien is a non-purchase money security interest in household goods held primarily for personal and household use, and is a type of lien which may be avoided in accordance with applicable provisions of the Bankruptcy Law.
