**ORDER GRANTING EXEMPTION
FROM ELECTRONIC PUBLIC ACCESS FEES**

Daniel A. Austin, Associate Professor of Law at Northeastern University School of Law, has requested an exemption from payment of fees associated with the use of the Public Access to Court Electronic Records ("PACER") system used by this Court through March 30, 2013, in connection with academic research regarding discharge of student loan debt in bankruptcy.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that PACER System Account #NU0076 shall be exempt from payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic files maintained in this Court to the extent such use is incurred in the course of academic research regarding discharge of student loan debt in bankruptcy. Additionally, the following limitations apply:

1. This fee exemption applies only to Account #NU0076 and is valid only for the purpose stated above.
2. This fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this Court that are available through the PACER system.
3. By accepting this exemption, Daniel A. Austin agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption.
4. This exemption is valid through March 30, 2013, but can be revoked at any time at the discretion of this Court.

5. The Clerk shall transmit a copy of this Order to the PACER Service Center.
