**ORDER GRANTING EXEMPTION  
FROM ELECTRONIC PUBLIC ACCESS FEES**

Lois R. Lupica, Maine Law Foundation Professor of Law, University of Maine School of Law, has requested an exemption from payment of fees associated with the use of the Public Access to Court Electronic Records ("PACER") system used by this Court through July 31, 2013, in connection with grants awarded by the American Bankruptcy Institute Endowment Fund and the National Conference of Bankruptcy Judges Endowment for Education Fund to study the effects of Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 (BAPCPA) on creditor distributions in consumer cases.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that PACER System Account #112801 shall be exempt from payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic files maintained in this Court to the extent such use is incurred in the course of academic research regarding bankruptcy. Additionally, the following limitations apply:

1. This fee exemption applies only to Account #112801 and is valid only for the purpose stated above.
2. This fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this Court that are available through the PACER system.
3. By accepting this exemption, Lois R. Lupica agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption.

4. This exemption is valid through July 31, 2013, but can be revoked at any time at the discretion of this Court.

5. The Clerk shall transmit a copy of this Order to the PACER Service Center.
