



## CM/ECF Query for Mobile Devices

The CM/ECF Query screen has a Mobile Query feature available for mobile devices. The Query screen has been reformatted for easier viewing and accessibility on smaller screens. This allows you portability with devices like iPads, iPhones, Androids and other similar products. PACER users can look for case data by case number, party, and full text searches within docket text in this condensed format. Other issues such as bandwidth or data transfer speed have also been addressed for more satisfactory results. Mobile Query can be accessed from CM/ECF or directly from the PACER case locator.
