The United States Trustee has adopted a new uniform pleading titled "Notice of Trustee's Final Report and Applications for Compensation (NFR)" (UST Form 101-7-NFR). This new notice contains mandatory language which differs from that provided for in Local Rule 9013-1. To accommodate the difference, the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Oklahoma shall be amended to add the following subsection to Local Rule 9013-1(D):

12. The Notice of Trustee's Final Report and Applications for Compensation (NFR) by a Chapter 7 trustee. The Notice of Trustee's Final Report and Applications for Compensation (NFR) shall contain the following language (or such other language as may be required by the United States Trustee):

Any person wishing to object to any fee application or the Final Report, must file a written objection within 20 days of the date of this notice, together with a request for a hearing and serve a copy of both upon the trustee, any party whose application is being challenged and the United States Trustee. If no objections are filed, the Court will act on the fee applications and the trustee may pay dividends pursuant to FRBP 3009 without further order of the Court.
