ORDER EXTENDING INTERIM BANKRUPTCY RULE 1007-I

On November 26, 2012, the Court entered General Order No. 12-GO-04, adopting Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I, to implement a provision of the National Guard and Reservists Debt Relief Act of 2008, Pub. L. No. 110-438, as amended by Pub. L. No. 112-64. Interim Rule 1007-I provides for a temporary exclusion from means testing for certain qualified members of the National Guard and reserve components of the Armed Forces. Attached to General Order No. 12-GO-04 as Exhibit B is a copy of Interim Rule 1007-I effective as of December 1, 2012, which provided, in footnote 1, that the exclusion applied in bankruptcy cases commenced in the seven-year period beginning December 19, 2008.

Since the entry of General Order No. 12-GO-04, Interim Rule 1007-I has been extended by legislation and is now applicable to bankruptcy cases commenced in the *fifteen-year period* beginning December 19, 2008.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Interim Rule 1007-I, adopted by virtue of General Order No. 12-GO-04, is hereby extended through December 18, 2023.
