GENERAL ORDER

Effective immediately, in order to decrease the risk of COVID-19 infection, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that all Visitors (defined below) to The Federal Building, 224 South Boulder, Tulsa, Oklahoma, shall wear masks or cloth face coverings in all common areas, elevators, stairwells, restrooms, and in meeting spaces where social distancing of six feet cannot be maintained.

Masks and face coverings must cover the nose and mouth completely.

Visitors subject to this order include, without limitation, Court and tenant employees, security personnel, litigants, attorneys and staff, vendors, contractors, and members of the public. Visitors lacking a mask or face covering will be denied entry to the building and should contact the Court or agency sought to be visited by telephone for further guidance.

Court employees who work alone in a private office or cubicle, or in a workspace that permits at least six feet of physical distance from other persons, may remove their face coverings while in the designated space. During in-person proceedings in courtrooms, the face covering requirement shall be at the discretion of the presiding judge.

Tenant agencies shall determine face covering requirements for employees and Visitors within their own internal spaces.

This Order shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
