

Pursuant to Local Rule 9010(b), an attorney who has been admitted to practice and remains in good standing before any other court of the United States, or before the highest court of any other State, and who is familiar with the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Oklahoma, may practice before this Court with permission of the Court. Permission to practice before the Court may be requested by filing a written motion or by making an oral request during any proceeding before this Court, followed by a written motion. *See* Local Rules 5005(c) and 9010(b) (effective April 1, 2000). This Court sets an admission fee in the amount of \$50.00. Said fee shall be remitted directly to the Clerk of the United States District Court for the Northern District of Oklahoma, 333 West 4th Street, Room 411, Tulsa, Oklahoma 74103. The remittance shall identify by case number the bankruptcy case in which permission to appear and practice is sought. Admission in a particular bankruptcy case shall also serve as admission in any and all adversary proceedings filed in said bankruptcy case.
