## MISC. ORDER 156

WHEREAS, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Oklahoma allows electronic filing of petitions on the CM/ECF System; and

WHEREAS, it has been proven that, on occasion, attorneys will file the same petition on the

system more than once thereby creating multiple bankruptcy cases with different numbers; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk has established procedures to verify duplicate filings and delete the duplicated case opened by the filing of the petition;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- Effective this date, the Court gives the Clerk the authority to delete duplicated cases opened on the CM/ECF System by following the established procedures and preserving the necessary documentation that will allow for a thorough audit of the deletion of the case.
- 2. Any duplicate case where filing fees have been paid will not be included in these established procedures but must remain open until closed by the court.
