ORDER

WHEREAS it has come to the attention of the Court that, from time to time, a debtor will be notified by the Bankruptcy Noticing Center ("BNC") that mail sent to a creditor or party in interest listed on the bankruptcy matrix has been returned as "undeliverable"; and

WHEREAS the notice provided by the BNC provides a mechanism whereby a debtor or debtor's counsel may provide an updated address for the creditor or party whose address has been designated as "undeliverable"; and

WHEREAS the notice provided by the BNC does not contain a caption relating the notice to the particular case at issue, and thus does not comply with Local Rule 1009-1(D) or Local Rule 9004-2; and

WHEREAS the Court, having reviewed the notice used by the BNC, finds that the same meets the needs of the Court and the Clerk of the Court notwithstanding the fact that said notice does not fully comply with Local Rule 1009-1(D) or Local Rule 9004-2,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that when a debtor is notified by the BNC that its creditor mailing list includes a creditor with an undeliverable mailing address, the debtor may amend its mailing list by filing a copy of the BNC's "Undeliverable Notice" on which the debtor has provided an updated address for the creditor. This document shall be filed and docketed as a "Notice of Change of Address of Creditor (BNC Undeliverable Notice)" and compliance with Local Rules 1009-1(D) (requiring an amendment to creditor list) and 9004-2 (requiring a caption) is hereby waived.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this General Order shall take effect immediately.
