30-Day Transcript (Ordinary) A transcript to be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$4.40	\$1.10	\$.75
14-Day Transcript A transcript to be delivered within fourteen (14) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$5.10	\$1.10	\$.75
7-Day Transcript (Expedited) A transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$5.85	\$1.10	\$.75
3-Day Transcript A transcript to be delivered within three (3) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$6.55	\$1.30	\$.90
Next-Day Transcript (Daily) A transcript to be delivered on the calendar day following receipt of the order (regardless of whether that calendar day is a weekend or holiday), prior to the normal opening hour of the clerk's office. <i>Please call the Clerk's Office to alert of a daily request.</i>	\$7.30	\$1.45	\$1.10
2-Hour Transcript (Hourly) A transcript of proceedings to be delivered within two (2) hours from receipt of the order. <i>Not available for this Court.</i>	\$8.70	\$1.45	\$1.10
Realtime Transcript A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following receipt of the order. <i>Not available for this Court.</i>	One feed, \$3.70 per page; two-to-four feeds, \$2.55 per page; five or more feeds, \$1.80 per page. Orders placed on or before the day of the proceeding will be batched together for purposes of determining the number of feeds; and subsequent orders will be charged at the lowest page rate assessed on the previous	N/A	N/A

Section 530.50 Descriptions of Fees for Services

§ 530.50 Descriptions of Fees for Services	
Item	Description
(a) Transcript Production	The fees cover all costs of transcript production.
(b) Original Fee	For any given proceeding/date there can only be one original charge. All other transcripts of the same proceeding must be at the copy rates. The original fee rate may not be charged to parties who order a transcript that was already produced at the request of a judge.
(c) 14-Day, 7-Day, Next-Day, and 2-Hour Transcripts	In the case of 14-day, 7-Day, Next-Day and 2-Hour transcripts, the approved fees are to cover all costs of transcript production, including payments to extra court reporters, typists, and transcribers to help produce the transcript. Note: 2-Hour Not offered by this Court
(d) Copy Fee	A copy fee is charged if the party orders and receives a copy.
(e) Fee for Sale of Transcript on Electronic Media	The rates allowed for electronic media transcripts are the same as those allowed for paper transcripts whether they represent originals, first copies, or additional copies. No additional charge is permitted for the cost of the electronic media.
(f) Compressed Transcripts	The maximum per page rate for each compressed original or copy of a transcript is the same as that for a full-size transcript.
(g) Realtime Feed	For realtime translation services, a rate is charged per page by the certified realtime court reporter. Note: Not offered by this Court

Example of Fee Calculation.

A party orders an original and one copy of an ordinary transcript of 50 pages. The court reporter charges the party at a rate of \$4.40 per page for the original and \$1.10 per page for the copy. The court reporter bills the party \$220.00 for the original and \$55.00 for the copy for a total bill of \$275.00, delivering both the original and the copy to the party. The court reporter also delivers to the clerk of court (through the court reporting supervisor) a copy of the transcript for the records of the court at no charge to the party or court. Another party orders two copies of the same transcript. The court reporter charges this party at a rate of \$1.10 per page for the first copy and \$.75 per page for the second copy. The court reporter bills

the party \$55.00 for the first copy and \$37.50 for the second copy for a total bill of \$92.50.
