WHEREFORE, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 521(a)(1)(B)(iv), a debtor is required to file copies of *all* payment advices or other evidence of payment (such as paycheck stubs, direct deposit statements, employer's statement of hours and earnings) received from the debtor's employer within 60 days before the date the debtor filed his/her bankruptcy case (the "petition date"), and

WHEREFORE, the judges of this Court desire to provide debtors and their counsel with a uniform means of reporting the information regarding such payment advices,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all individual debtors shall file with the Clerk of the Court a "Payment Advices Certification" in the form as is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said document, together with the necessary attachments (if any), shall be filed not later than 45 days after the petition date.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that failure to timely file the "Payment Advices Certification" shall constitute cause for dismissal of a bankruptcy case.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall apply to all cases filed after the date of entry of this Order.
